

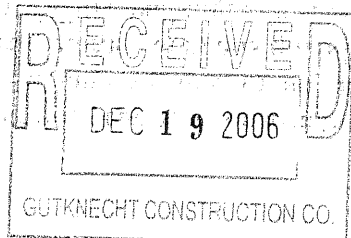
Dear Mr. Fineman,


Dear Mr. Tiffany:

The work was performed on schedule with no incident of injury, lost time, or damages. The job was completed to our satisfaction and specifications.

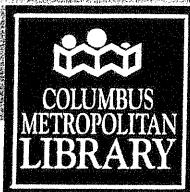

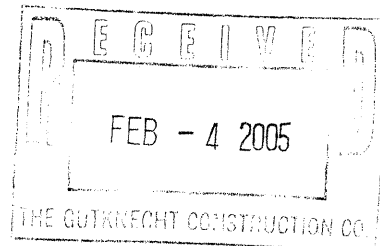


